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Seasonal retail workers in high demand

► HOLIDAY JOBS: Some retailers are offering perks to entice temporary workers this holiday season.

Retailers won't just be battling each other for customers this holiday season — they also are gearing up to fight over the temporary workers who will make the sales.

A strong economy has retailers expecting a busy holiday shopping season, but with unemployment near historic lows, staffing up to handle extra demand could be a challenge.

Target plans to hire 120,000 people to fill seasonal jobs in its 1,839 stores, about 20 percent more than last year. That matches the number of jobs Amazon announced ahead of last year's holiday season and is the largest seasonal hiring estimate from a bricks-and-mortar retailer since Challenger, Gray & Christmas began tracking the figure in 2012.

The retailer said it needs more seasonal workers to handle online orders from stores, such as in-store or curbside pickup or shipping items to customers' homes. The company said it plans to hire nearly twice as many seasonal workers to fill online orders compared with last

FedEx also said it plans to hire more seasonal workers this year: 55,000, up from 50,000 in a group sing-along with a very

Macy's plans to hire about seasonal workers the same number it initially announced last year before adding another 7,000 holiday jobs in December. But fewer of this year's group of holiday hires will be working in Macy's stores. About 23,500 of the 80,000 jobs are in fulfillment centers handling online orders, up from 18,000 last year, the Cincinnatibased department store chain said.

Retailers have cut thousands of jobs while closing stores in recent years, but they also have created new ones in areas supporting growing online sales, such as fulfillment centers, logistics and transportation.

Some retailers, like Kohl's and J.C. Penney, began hiring seasonal workers significantly

earlier than in prior years. Wisconsin-based Kohl's announced in June — about three months earlier than last year — that seasonal jobs were available at more than 300 stores. Additional hiring started at all stores, distribution and fulfillment centers in August, and Kohl's has been holding hiring events in stores. Target and Macy's have scheduled nationwide hiring events in October.

Target said all new hires him. would start at a minimum wage of \$12 per hour and get store discounts. As a new perk, the retailer will randomly select one hourly worker at each store and distribution center to receive a \$500 gift card and \$500 donation to a local community organization of their choice.

Kohl's, which plans to hire more than 90,000 seasonal workers, has competitive wages, a weekly pay schedule and certain days when employees get larger-than-usual discounts, spokeswoman Julia Markun said. Macy's also said it gives seasonal workers competitive merchandise discounts and the ability to earn quarterly incentives if they achieve certain goals.

Downey grapples with profane gadfly

► GOVERNMENT: City Council meetings have become increasingly hostile and vulgar due to a single public speaker who tests the limits of his First Amendment rights.

DOWNEY - You're sitting in the City Hall council chambers, anxiously awaiting the City Council's decision on one particular item.

The mayor leans over and pulls his microphone close to



Every person who steps into a council meeting has an opportunity to speak their

minds, voice their concerns, and either support or speak out against a particular agenda item. The rules of engagement between council and a speaker

"It is requested that all persons wishing to speak to the Council shall state their name, address, and the subject matter upon which they wish to speak for the record. All speakers who wish to address members of the City Council or staff must do so through the Mayor. No person shall address the Council until he or she has first been recognized by the Mayor. The decision of the Mayor to recognize or not recognize a person may be changed by order of the Council. In the interest of facilitating the business of the Council, persons addressing the Council shall be limited to five (5) minutes unless such time is extended by the Mayor for good

and

"There will be one oral communication section near the beginning of the City Council Agenda placed after public hearings. During this time members of the public may address the Council on any nonagenda item which is directly related to City business. Each person speaking shall be limited to five (5) minutes per speaker and the maximum time allowed for oral communication shall be thirty (30) minutes. For good cause the Mayor may extend the time for individual speakers or the maximum time for oral communications.

Council members are not legally allowed to dialogue with speakers, however, the mayor can direct each individual to a member of city staff according to their needs.

For most, this opportunity is taken only once or twice at meetings that are few and far between. Even those who are meeting regulars often don't have too much to say.

However, there is the occasional exceptional individual - aka a "gadfly" - who seems to choose to get their money's worth out of the opportunity,

speaking at every available necessarily gadflies. They just moment for every agenda item as haven't gotten the answers they well as public comment.

So what exactly is a gadfly?

According to former Mayor Mario Guerra, gadflies are one of the "icky" parts that come with the job of serving on city council.

"Fortunately, and unfortunately, it's part of the process of democracy," said

Still, not all public speakers are - nor should - be branded with the label of gadfly. That being said, where exactly is the line in the sand drawn?

'The line was if you keep bringing up the same thing when you already know the answer; if you're bringing it up just to be a pest or something," said Guerra. "Obviously, we want to listen to the people. We were always very accepting; that was one of my favorite times because I got to hear what the people had to say.

"In open meetings you can't have a dialogue with people during the non-agenda open comment, but you could direct the conversation to a city staffer to take care of it...those are all legitimate.

"Where it became silly sometimes is there's verbal threats, name-calling, and the same person coming up more than once in the same meeting, every single subject bringing up the same subject.'

Another former mayor, David Gafin, offered a more cautionary

'You really cannot take a whole subject of a gadfly and put it on one shelf, because it depends on their purpose behind " said Gafin. "Are they doing it just because they want the notoriety, because they like to be the fly in the ointment...or do they have a legitimate complaint about a specific subject that is obviously near and dear and should be paid attention to?"

"Most gadflies, except those that are way out there, are not

want to hear."

Gadflies are nothing new to Downey City Council, and both Gafin and Guerra have had their fair share of experiences with them.

"We used to have a gadfly, his name was Lenny [Whittington]... it got scary to the point because he felt empowered to walk right up to the dais," said Guerra. "We literally put up a little courtroom wall type of thing right there up front [so] that you couldn't walk in there. At least it's a barrier, it's a visual barrier...'

"We've had those who have come up there because they know they have their five minutes,' said Gafin. "We've had people come up there with books and just read a chapter out of the book or until the five minutes were up, close the book and sit down because they can talk for five minutes on anything they want. Of course, you'd rather have it be about city work or something that we want to address or respond to, or whatever the case may be, but we have our First Amendment rights."

The subject of how and how long public speaking opportunities should be handled has recently been the subject of some debate not only in Downey, but in the local region. This is partly due to gadfly nuisance.

A proposal to bar repeatedly disruptive individuals from Los Angeles Council and Committee meetings for several days at a time manifested early this month after multiple complaints from city lawmakers of disruptions in and out of the council chambers.

The proposal came two days after what can only be described as normal, bombastic meeting behavior from regular LA gadfly Armando Herman, who was removed from the meeting after using vulgar and profane language, then continued to disrupt the meeting even after having sat down.

Herman is also a regular at

Downey meetings. His language there is often sharp-tongued, fiery, and profanity laced as well, however his actions don't seem as exaggerated once seated as in

Still, former Mayor Fernando Vasquez, who is currently serving in his last few months as a part of the council, locked horns with Herman last year in a controversial spat that saw Herman ejected and threatening litigation against the city.

"I was frustrated, and I was concerned that there were children in the audience and you had somebody what I perceived as making a mockery out of the public comment process," said Vasquez. "He used profanity, I warned him and he did it again. So, I elected to have him removed from the chamber."

In fact, it seems as though profanity is where most on the council - past and present takes the most issue.

"Relating to the council issue or any comments in there, I would

Unfortunately for Vasquez and the other former mayors, vulgar language is not enough to legally eject a speaker from a meeting, as explained by City Attorney Yvette Garcia after a recent, typical Herman tirade.

"The profanity that the community has heard is not one that goes unnoticed here," said Garcia at the Aug. 28 council "Unfortunately, the meeting. > Since last year's controversy, Vasquez has had an opportunity to reflect and learn from the incident.

> 'You certainly want to give everybody the opportunity to voice their concerns or their opinions on things. I'm a firm believer in due process," said Vasquez. "I have a philosophical difference when somebody is shouting profanity in a derogatory manner where they're intentionally doing it just to get attention. Having said that, I now understand what the legalities are. I disagree with the law, but I have to respect the law.





I'm not above the law."

Vasquez says that there are ways to express their dissatisfaction or concerns without using derogatory or vulgar language.

"If you have somebody constantly doing it in a way that they're making a mockery out of democracy, I have an issue with that," said Vasquez.

Vazquez says that he had opened up discussion on potentially cutting down Downey's allotted speaker time from five minutes, however was not able to garner the support.

Guerra, Gafin, and Vasquez all shared the thought that regardless of time allotted, the Mayor is the one who holds control over the time and flow of public comment.

"I think the control over them, or how you try and lead them more or less, is up to each mayor," said Gafin.

"You have to try, you have to keep decorum," added Guerra.

With the end of the year the mayor is not as strong and he yes three minutes should be an approaching and an annual mayoral transition due in just a handful of months, that duty may very well fall to current Mayor Pro Tem Rick Rodriguez in 2019.

Like many of his council associates, Rodriguez - who was elected in 2016 - has seen, heard, and been the target of bi-weekly gadfly scrutiny and attack.

It is of Rodriguez's opinion that the mayor's gavel currently may be underutilized.

"I think that gavel is a powerful tool. That gavel is not used enough in my opinion," said Rodriguez. "That gavel can be used to draw attention... there's no need to have a lack of respect, so I think that gavel Is an underused tool for the mayor."

Respect is high on the priority list for Rodriguez, and he has indicated that he is not afraid to take a stand for it.

"If the mayor is strong enough to be in control of the situation, I think that certain people who speak out of turn may be a little more willing to obey the rules," said Rodriguez. "If

just allows things to keep going for five whole minutes, then it's going to go and go and go and now the speaker feels empowered."

"I give a lot of my time, my heart, and my energy to our city because I love our city so much, but at the same time – it could be inside the city council chamber, it could be on the street - I will not allow anybody to disrespect our city; it's not going to happen on my watch."

Like Vasquez before him, Rodriguez has concerns about the current length of time given to speakers, especially if they seem to abuse the right. With that considered, there is a possibility that an old conversation may be resurrected.

"We're one of the only organizations, the only agency that allows five minutes. Go to the county, go to the state, it's never more than three minutes,' said Rodriguez. "It's an option... I think that the gavel is a tool that can direct that flow of [verbal] traffic, wherever it may go. If that doesn't change things, then

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option."

When asked about the possibility of cutting time down, both Guerra and Gafin pushed "For many years we've had

this five-minute limitation; I don't see that needs to be altered any," said Gafin. "Just because you don't like what somebody is saying doesn't mean you should shorten them." "I caution anything that

hinders free speech," said Guerra. "Cutting the time, I think that's a purgative. I wouldn't cut it too much. Five minutes might be too long or too short, but you've got to give the opportunity to speak."

Instead, Guerra offers the difficult situation as a "balance."

"It's a balance - free speech, constituents, nuisance, safety - those things, it's a delicate balance," said Guerra. "But I think you always have to err or lean on the free speech."

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Is this any way to confirm a Supreme Court justice?

Until two weeks ago, President Donald Trump's nomination of Judge Brett Kavanaugh to a seat on the U.S. Supreme Court seemed a sure thing. He ably handled more than 1,200 questions put to him by members of the Senate Judiciary Committee. He demonstrated even to his adversaries a masterful command of constitutional jurisprudence. The FBI had completed six background investigations of Kavanaugh throughout his career in government, and it found no blemishes.

Trump promised that he would appoint federal judges and justices who generally share his views on life, guns and administrative regulations and who have a minimalistic view of federal power. When he announced the Kavanaugh nomination, it appeared he had found his man.

nomination requires Senate confirmation by a majority vote. The Senate currently has 51 Republicans and 49 Democrats. A few Republican senators do not share the president's stated views on the judiciary, and a few Democrats do. The inside consensus was that enough Democratic senators running for re-election in states that Trump carried in 2016 would vote to confirm Kavanaugh and those Democrats would handily offset the few Republicans who might oppose him.

During his confirmation hearings, Kavanaugh dutifully followed the pattern of all current sitting justices at their confirmation hearings by declining to answer hypothetical questions which sought answers as to how he might vote on certain issues likely to come before the court. He survived the grueling cross-examination by Committee Democrats and even won begrudging praise from a few.

Then, Sen. Dianne Feinstein, a Democratic member of the Judiciary Committee, dropped a bombshell.

She revealed that a constituent who wished to remain anonymous had written a letter to a member of the House of Representatives, who had turned the letter over to Feinstein. The letter contained allegations by the writer, Dr. Christine Blasey Ford, that Kavanaugh had drunkenly attempted sexual assault against her 36 years ago. Feinstein had the letter for two months before she revealed its existence a week after the Kavanaugh confirmation hearings had ended.

This is reminiscent of allegations leveled by Professor Anita Hill against then-Judge Clarence Thomas, though those allegations were of inappropriate words in the workplace and the Ford allegations are of force and violence in a bedroom. When Hill's allegations were published, President George H.W. Bush dispatched the FBI to resume its background investigation of Thomas, and it did so.

Trump has declined to dispatch the FBI to investigate Ford's allegations, and other allegations that have now followed hers, because he and Senate Republicans are determined to seat Kavanaugh by next week.

In the absence of an FBI investigation, Ford gave an interview to The Washington Post in which she aired her complaints in graphic detail, despite missing facts and fuzzy recollections. Democrats demanded that the Judiciary Committee hear from her

and again from Kavanaugh. They appear to be assuming that Kavanaugh should not enjoy the American presumption of innocence and — without hearing a word from Ford or seeing any corroborating evidence - have concluded that Kavanaugh must be guilty of this alleged offense and thus cannot be confirmed.

Then the folks in the White House who are managing the Kavanaugh nomination advised him to violate Criminal Procedure 101: Don't deny publicly an allegation before it has credibly and publicly been made. So, Kavanaugh was interviewed by my Fox News colleague Martha MacCallum. Her questions were far better than his answers.

His answers to the allegations contained in a newspaper story were three-fold — he didn't do it, he wants a fair process and unthinkably — he was a virgin during his high school and college years. I say "unthinkably" not because virginity is beyond belief but because this claim was not in response to any of MacCallum's questions and it bore so deeply into Kavanaugh's personhood as to be none of the public's business. And it is not a defense to the Ford allegations.

What's going on here?

What's going on is crisis and panic. The pro-choice Democrats are in crisis: They are so fearful of a decisive vote to limit the Supreme Court's abortion jurisprudence that they are willing to destroy a qualified judge's career to block his advancement. And Kavanaugh's handlers, who, at this writing, probably lack the votes for confirmation, have recklessly put him on the offensive, even if it is debasing and

Now we await a potentially tragic confrontation on national television between Ford and Kavanaugh, which will come down to perception rather than reality. The issue is not whether he did it. Rather, it is whether his denials are more believable than her allegations. At the end of their Judiciary Committee confrontation, will the general public perception be that Ford was more credible or that Kavanaugh was more credible?

There are no rules here. Ford has no legal obligation to prove her allegations, and Kavanaugh has no legal obligation to disprove

A tie — the public perception that Ford and Kavanaugh are equally credible — will be very troublesome for Kavanaugh. No woman would go through what Ford is going through if she lacked a personal commitment to the truth. So Kavanaugh can only win if Dr. Christine Ford is generally disbelieved.

The Kavanaugh nomination was supposed to be Trump's gift to his pro-life, conservative, evangelical base. It has become anything but that. If Judge Brett Kavanaugh is confirmed, will he ever lose the taint of these allegations? If he is not confirmed, can he return to the second-highest court in the land, on which he now sits? Is this how the framers expected the selection process for the Supreme Court to play out? In a word: No.

Crybaby. We know who you were in high school, Brett Kavanaugh, in college, and so on.

The public case against Kavanaugh's character is building, rising like a river. He can't believe this is happening to him, the lucky golden boy. Christine Blasey Ford's story of a sexual assault incident, which she is telling at great cost to herself, will not move these men from their stony heights. If that's what Kavanaugh did, they really don't care. It took me a long time to learn that the truth will not set you free

Rural Iowa's cranky, salty Senator Charles Grassley, 85, chairs the committee. He may not have heard of the #MeToo movement. One of Hill's tormentors, Senator Orrin Hatch, R-Utah, has not learned much in 27 years.

A cloud of deja vu is hanging over me — and you, too? People galvanized by the Senate's shabby treatment of Hill in 1991 are bracing to support Dr. Blasey (as she is known professionally) as she faces hostile questions.

Even worse, the Republicans have hired a female lawyer to ask the questions, trying to hide their all-male optics. Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell, R-Ky., refused to reveal her name, and said the move will ensure the hearing is "respectful."

There are four good Democratic women on the committee, and several men. Just you wait, Judge Kavanaugh, for Sens. Kamala Harris, D-Calif., and Dick Durbin, D-Ill.


NASA's accomplishments

Paging Dr. Frischer...

How can a diet that pushes butter, red meat and bacon, eliminates complex carbohydrates like fruits, vegetables, and whole grains, be a good thing? I'm frequently asked about the ketogenic (keto) diet. Admittedly, I began my investigation with a distinctly negative bias.

Back in the 1920s, researchers observed that children with epilepsy improved on this type of diet, and it has remained in the medical textbooks ever since. There is now speculation that other groups of people might benefit from it, including those with neurodegenerative disorders such as multiple Parkinson's sclerosis, and Alzheimer's disease, and even those with traumatic brain injuries.

The keto diet allows very few or no carbohydrates, which are the body's main source of energy. The body is then forced into a state of ketosis, where fat is burned for energy instead of carbohydrates. The keto diet includes large amounts of highfat foods, including red meat, avocado, coconut milk, oils, nuts and nut butter, bacon, egg

yolks, butter and cheese. It also includes fish and seafood, lowcarb vegetables, meat, poultry, and plain yogurt. A very small quantity of leafy greens, broccoli, asparagus, cucumber, celery, tomatoes, peppers, mushrooms and zucchini are allowed.

Excluded foods include fruit, bread, pasta, legumes, beans, starchy vegetables like sweet potatoes, vegetables like winter squash, beets, or carrots, most processed foods, and anything with added sugar. Calories break down to about 75% fat, 20% protein, and 5% carbohydrate. This is dramatically different from the standard American diet, where the proportions are closer to 50% carbohydrates, 30% fats, and 20% protein.

Surprisingly, both research and anecdotal evidence have shown that this high fat diet can loss. The body is forced to burn cravings and increase the feeling of being full.

The keto diet is also recognized for helping to

control insulin sensitivity and release, which plays a vital role in controlling diabetes. When carbohydrates are eliminated, an overload of insulin is avoided, and more balanced blood sugar levels result.

By now, my readers should be expecting to see the word "however."

- · HOWEVER, our brains use sugar to perform. Without carbohydrates, glucose doesn't enter the blood stream, resulting in a decline in brain function.
- · HOWEVER, starvation due to a prolonged lack of carbohydrates can lead to the body losing muscle and energy. Note that once the body enters starvation mode, it can actually be more difficult to shed weight.
- · HOWEVER, athletes avoid the keto diet. Low carbohydrate and high fat diets have been shown to do a poor job at feeding the muscles, reducing muscle mass and peak sports performance.
- · HOWEVER, while studies indeed be effective for weight do show that consumption of large amounts of saturated fats fat for energy. In addition, eating can actually level out cholesterol high fat foods can help minimize levels (temporarily), this diet can ultimately result in much higher blood cholesterol, which can cause far more harm than good, particularly to the heart.

Studies have not yet examined the long-term possible negative impacts on the heart, kidneys, nutritional deficiencies, hydration, cholesterol, etc. The keto diet is recommended only for short-term use, generally for a maximum of 12 weeks. It is not a good idea for the long run, is very difficult to maintain, and doesn't offer a good option for a full lifestyle change.

I do find the ketogenic diet fascinating because it forces the body to digest fat, thereby targeting body fat stores, resulting in weight loss. The data on treating certain neurodegenerative diseases is promising, and is undergoing further study. The data on diabetes control is also noteworthy. But remember that we need carbohydrates to fuel our brains and our bodies.

The best diet in the longterm is one that builds healthy and sustainable habits. If you are considering the keto diet, I urge you to evaluate with your doctor whether it is appropriate for your own unique health profile.

Rancho opens new hospital wing

A lightly and brightly dressed crowd attended the ribboncutting ceremonies for the new Jacquelin Perry Wing at Downey's Rancho Los Amigos National Rehabilitation Center last week.

Sunshine and a light breeze made a perfect California morning and a String Quartet from the Downey Symphony played baroque airs as the crowd settled under the big white tent marked by blue and white balloons. Downey Mayor Pro-Tem Rick Rodriguez welcomed everyone and then County Supervisor Janice Hahn praised the City of Downey for working with the county to make this "life-changing elegant building"

"We've got the best care in the world right here," she said.

Also greeting the throng were **Aires Limbaga**, Rancho's new executive director, and Mark Ridley-Thomas, chairman of the Board of Supervisors.

Set within the ring of Downey's encircling freeways lies this sparkling gem, Rancho Los Amigos Rehabilitation

A world within a world, Rancho's reputation radiates worldwide. One special name is **Dr. Jacquelin Perry**, famed for her contributions to the biometrics of locomotion.

The ribbon cutting marked the opening of a new glass and limestone building with its lacy metallic screen façade, the extension of the Institute that bears her name. This new wing now brings all inpatients under one convenient roof.

Who is the woman who helped put Rancho on the map? Dr. Perry first trained as an orthopedic surgeon, and was one of the first 10 women to be certified by the American Board of Orthopedic Surgery. She did spinal fusion and tendon transfer surgery, and then later began her pioneer work in gait-research in stroke victims, followed by post-polio patients, spinal cord injuries and cerebral palsy victims.

By careful measured observations Dr. Perry was able to break down human gait into eight motion patters in 28 major muscles in each leg, with the goal of restoring mobility to her patients.

"She was always curious, and she was a problem solver," said Joanne Gronley, a Rancho research kinesthesiologist and also a board member of the Downey Symphonic Society.

Dr. Perry resided in Downey

till she died in 2013 at age 94, and was a longtime enthusiastic patron of the Symphonic Society as well as a Platinum donor to

Wheelchairs zipped among the pedestrians and scooted around attendees with canes and walkers and the campus with its blue and white balloons looked like "the happiest place on earth." Green scrub suits alternated with long white "doctor coats" and the jackets of therapists, as staff and patients mingled with Downey fans of Rancho, and there were many, representing many local service organizations.

The new wing is an inpatient facility which consolidates all hospital beds into one

structure and incorporates advanced technology. The main Jacqueline Perry Institute (JPI) facility currently cares for approximately 4,000 patients annually.

The wing is so new it still smells like a new car. The shelves in the gift shop have yet to be stocked, the warming dishes in the cafeteria yet to be filled. But a therapy garden has already been planted, for its soothing effect on patients and their families. Space is set aside for them to cultivate flowers and vegetables or simply rest and meditate. Art in Rancho has a place here too.

The new JPI facilities are a cornerstone in "Rancho Rising 2020" and Downey's own redevelopment plans. Of vital interest to Downey are the plans for redevelopment of 15 acres of Rancho's vast campus for a park with soccer fields.

The hospital facilities are only part of the magnificent

138-year Rancho History. There is the Don Knabe Wellness Center, a state of the art work-out and physical training facility dedicated in 2016, which features a full gym, swimming pool, underwater treadmills and other rehabilitation tools.

Now that polio has been almost completely

eradicated from the earth, the hospital specializes in brain, neurological, orthopedic, pediatric, spinal injury and stroke rehabilitation. Once the County Poor Farm, Rancho today continues its "tradition of innovation."



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
