Rives Mansion gets OK for controversial renovation

Downey's most historic home will be converted into nine office spaces, and a cafe will be constructed on the front lawn.

DOWNEY - A controversial plan that will see Downey's historic Rives Mansion converted into office space was tediously Planning approved by the Commission early Thursday

Current mansion owners Erika De La Teja and her husband had their work cut out for them entering Wednesday's hearing, having submitted plans to refurbish and convert the residential home into nine commercial office spaces, along with constructing a new 1,200 square foot coffee shop and juice bar retail café.

It took several hours and a handful of added conditions for the evening's highest profile agenda item to come to a conclusion, with the final 3-2 vote (Chairman Steve Dominguez and Commissioner Patrick Owens opposed) not coming until shortly after midnight.

De La Teja said that she was plan. "semi-happy with the results."

"I think there's a lot of conditions that were added that will negatively impact the construction process, but overall I'm happy," said De La Teja. "Just cost issues."

In fact, most of the residents who chose to address the commission seemed generally in favor of the proposed commercial eyesore was "a little bit harsh." use of the historic building.

The proposed café, however, garnered significant pushback.

The café was to as everything from an "abomination" to an "eyesore,' with some feeling that its location obstructed the view and therefore took away from the mansion.

However, staff said that the café's location had been selected after all other options - including the widely preferred northeastern corner of the property had been exhausted.

According to staff, already existing elements in that area of the public right-of-way complicated any placement of the café in the preferred corner, including manhole covers, a street light, and an awkwardly positioned street crossing.

Dominguez said that the café was "destroying the beauty, the value, and the aesthetic, and the history.

"We take a look at the property, its historical value, the photographic rendering, I'll be honest with you, if it was me I'd take a look at that and say, 'Oh my God, what am I doing?,'" said Dominguez. "Really, if you're sincere in wanting to maintain the Rives Mansion, then why are we dealing with this retail eyesore?"

Owens added that "preserving the mansion at all cost is the

Before the final vote, Vice Chair Miguel Duarte said that this was "probably the best-case scenario for the current property.

"This is a give and take," said Duarte. "Everybody wants to see the mansion restored...how do we do that? The applicant is willing to restore that property, have it for office use, but to make it a viable project there has to be some retail aspect because this is a business.'

"I think I agree with most of the commissioners here, it's not ideal, the location. I have to take what the staff is saying at face, saying it's just not feasible in the north-east corner...'

In an attempt to keep the owners honest and accountable, the café will also only initially be able to operate on a 90-day permit until refurbishment of the historical structures is completed.

Another issue was that of public access to the building, with many – especially Commissioners Owens and Jimmy Spathopoulos feeling that the building should still provide educational opportunities.

It was therefore decided by the commission that the owners will need to coordinate with the Downey Conservancy, Downey Historical Society, or some other qualified historical entity for quarterly tours to be open to the

De La Teja said that she had no issue with this, saying "it was always going to be public access on the grounds."

'That was always going to be public access anyways because of the café," said De La Teja. "In reality, if the city wants to provide somebody that can tour it for the oublic, i don't see a problem with that.

"It's a landmark so I'd assume people would be curious and they'd want to see it...it doesn't bother us."

Downey students lead team to rocket payload competition

DOWNEY - Two Downey High School students were able to return to school saying "mission complete" after a summer competition had them gazing onward and upward.

DHS seniors Andres Ruiz, 16, and Joseph Ramirez, 17, led a team of nine aerospace engineer-minded Vikings to the 2019 United Launch Alliance (ULA) student rocket launch program in Colorado this past July. The competition began in January and carried into the students break from school.



Students were tasked with building a payload that would be ejected from a rocket at approximately 4000 feet. If all goes to plan, the students' design would find its way down to a ground target.

The three closest teams would win a cash prize.

Ruiz and Ramirez were the team's sole representatives.

While the official results are not yet known, Downey's team unfortunately hit a last-minute snag that left them at a distinct

"The night before, they banned UAV's, which meant anything with a remote control that was in the sky couldn't compete for safety reasons, and our design was a drone," said Ramirez. "We weren't able to compete to our full capacity.

This curveball was especially frustrating for Ruiz and Ramirez, who say they have put in hundreds of dollars of their own money into their design in addition to the other funding they received from sponsors. They also met with their team several times a week for up

"It was really frustrating, especially because of all the time and work we put in," said Ramirez. "The best thing we could do was get the exact weight of a payload and have it parachute a certain distance and hope it's close enough.'

"The night before, we were doing calculations of how much weight would get us closest to the target," added Ruiz.

The abrupt change in strategy made it hard to compete with other teams who used rovers to drive their payload to the target after landing, Ramirez said.

Although in their senior year, Ruiz and Ramirez are far from done with the ULA competition.

"I think we may be leading another team next year, since United Launch Alliance, they said they might give us another spot for next year since the FAA banned our drone," said Ruiz. "We'll definitely be leading that."

School board considers adding new LGBTQ+ curriculum

The curriculum would comply with new state regulations mandating courses on gender and sexual orientation, sexual violence prevention, and sexually transmitted diseases.

DOWNEY - The Downey Unified School District may be adopting a new health curriculum for secondary school level students titled "Teen Talk," in compliance with the 2016 California Healthy Youth Act

Designed Connected, a coalition of education, health and human service providers founded in 1988, the curriculum coincides with their mission statement of equipping young people with information, skills, and support to make thoughtful choices about their relationships and sexual

After a committee of teachers and counselors met to review and vote on the curriculum that best fit the needs of DUSD, "Teen Talk" was introduced to the Board of Education in March.

"Teen Talk" introduces topics relevant to the social climate of today, especially in regards to inclusivity of the LGBTQ+ community.

The curriculum also provides comprehensive teaching material on gender and sexual orientation, body image and the media, sexual violence prevention, and relationships, as well as information on reproductive health, sexually transmitted infections pregnancy.

If implemented, students can expect to explore gender and sexual identity through a 'genderbread" person, while identifying their own sexual bill of rights as they discuss consent through defining what sexual assault and harassment mean, as well as thoroughly discussing healthy and unhealthy relationships, among other various, required topics.

The "genderbread person" activity uses an image of gingerbread cookie differentiate between gender identity, gender expression, biological sex, and attraction.

Using the gingerbread cookie as a visual, there are spectrums shown beside it to accentuate the idea that much of a person's gender and sexual identity are

Creating a sexual bill of rights is an activity that coincides with the discussion of consent, and having rights to your own body. Students would be shown the definitions of various terms, such as sexual assault and rape, and then be given a worksheet titled "Your Sexual Bill of Rights." The worksheet states the rights they have to change their mind and report a rape, as well as resources and statistics among other information on the issue.

Defining what a healthy relationship does and does not look like is another aspect of the curriculum in which students are provided with information on the cycle of violence, signs of an abusive relationship, and the chance to take an introspective look at their own relationship tendencies.

Through worksheet titled "Healthy Relationships Brainstorm," students are asked various questions regarding the way they interact in their own personal relationships, as well as what expectations they may have while in a relationship.

Throughout every section, the instructor would give an anonymous question to the "Anonymous Question Box" at the beginning of the session. By doing this, students are made to feel comfortable enough to ask questions they may not have of the entire class.

The goal for the instructor is to try to answer all questions with the help of several guidelines in facts sheet, "parents/guardians to try to answer all questions with place to follow. These guidelines state that all questions must the instruction by submitting a be pre-screened to determine request in writing." 





Treat social networks for what they are: modern-day résumés

Every hiring manager will do a Google search on your name, most companies keep an eye on your social networks, and in several industries, you're expected to have an online presence. With all this online performance, is it possible to retain some semblance of privacy?

Digging through a job candidate's or employee's social media is commonplace. According to a CareerBuilder survey from 2017, around 70 percent of polled employers screen a candidate's social media accounts before bringing them in for an interview. That same poll also found that over 50 percent of employers found candidates with no social footprint problematic. Which means most of us need to find some sort of balance.

I asked a handful of freelance journalists and designers how they approach social media and they all told me the same thing: They treat it all like the public forums that they are. Their various profiles exist as professional outlets and nothing else. For job seekers in a time when "culture fit" is nearly as important as skills, every social network might as well be

Your social networks don't need to be a full expression of yourself. You can pick and choose which ones represent what version of yourself you want to present, and which ones are public-facing. We have no problem compartmentalizing and customizing our IRL personas depending on all sorts of factors, like being at work, or a nice restaurant, or at a barbecue for a kid's birthday. Doing the same thing online shouldn't be a problem. A former editor of mine, Adam Pash, describes this as the piecemeal approach, and it's one of the few tactics for controlling an online identity that makes sense to me.

Pick a couple of social networks you want to use for work. and leave the rest private or don't engage with them at all. This method also makes it easy to abandon a service when it inevitably makes some bad choices and allows you to define the community based on what you're sharing.

Of course, we also shouldn't share everything publicly, but we're still social creatures with access to a wide variety of tools for communicating with one another. Every freelancer, job hunter or semipublic figure I chatted with used a variation of a hacked-together "private social network" to chat with small to medium-size groups. They essentially sandboxed their social selves into various less public apps, like a group text, Slack or Discord.

New parents relegated baby pictures to private album sharing or dedicated apps like Tinybeans. A pair of siblings used Snapchat solely for family in-jokes. It's mostly the sort of conversations that used to happen on Facebook before threads were made unintentionally public, alerting friends-of-friends that so-and-so's aunt had commented on your brother's wife's status update. It's easier and more private to just share directly with the people we actually like talking to.

But don't forget that even if you do create smaller, more personal networks, anything you do online can be made public, either by a hack or another party in a conversation. We saw the most bluntly obvious version of this when Harvard rescinded its admission offer to Kyle Kashuv after former classmates posted screenshots of racist comments in a Google Doc file on Twitter. It's best to assume everything you do and say online can be

exposed, even if it's not on a public social network.

Just having an account on a social network generates all sorts of data about you. There's not much you can do about that. A browser extension, like Privacy Badger, can at least cut off datahungry social media sites like Facebook and Twitter.

There's another option for developing an online presence that doesn't leak any data you don't want it to, if you're willing to put in the effort: a personal website. Last year, a Vice reporter, Jason Koebler, made a compelling case for bringing personal websites back into style. Before Facebook, setting up your own page on sites like Xanga or LiveJournal was common, and the data controls were simple. This technology is still available to us, easier to use then ever, and gives you control over the privacy levers. Just don't share a résumé with your phone number on it.

Personal websites are already a must-have in a variety of industries, and paying to set up your own guarantees the data is generally in your control. Buying your own domain and setting up a site also gets you a dedicated email address, like yourname@yourname.com, and pulls you away from Google's obtrusive Gmail.

Bonus: When your web address is your name, there's a good chance it'll bubble up to the top of Google search results with little effort from you.

Retaining the type of social footprint required for work while still managing personal privacy isn't easy, nor is it foolproof. Terms of service and privacy policies change on a whim, and sites like Facebook tend to move the various privacy toggles around so often that it's hard to keep track of what you've changed. If you must be online, a requirement for so many jobs these days, at least take control over what's shared and treat a majority of social networks for what they are: a résumé.

The undersigned, Bob Brazelton and Vicki Carnevale, resided and raised a family in Downey during the period covered by Aron Ramirez's needlessly lengthy seven articles, the last of which appeared in the Patriot Aug. 25 issue.

We each became Downeyites in 1957. Vicki and her husband, Ugo, purchased their home that year (for \$10,000). And Bob and his wife, Jean, did so in 1960 (\$23,000). We each are now widowed and reside in our same homes.

Bob and Jean raised six children, who attended parochial schools, while Vicki and Ugo raised three children, who attended local public schools. We and our spouses were very active throughout Downey while residing here. Bob chaired a committee that drafted Downey's charter in 1960, served on the Planning Commission for eight years in the 1980's, and the City Council for eight years during the 1990's. Jean volunteered on city commissions, service clubs and taught and helped in schools attended by her children.

Vicki headed committees at the public schools attended by her children, volunteered with Girl Scouts and on church committees. Her two sons (now doctors) played football for Warren High and each was study body president. Her daughter is a retired middle school teacher. Ugo coached many teams and was very active in the YMCA.

We, so to speak, have been on the "ground floor" to observe the changes in Downey. Here are some of our observations.

Downey has a city manager form of government with a governing body of five council persons. The quality of the city has much to do with the quality of the city manager and the council persons. The quality of the residents, of course, also is crucial.

Downey is fortunate to have had generally quality city managers, particularly the present one (Gilbert Livas) and his predecessor, Gerald Caton. The city also has generally had good council people who served as "volunteers" and didn't use the office as a vehicle to get rich.

We feel that Aron's articles regarding demographic change overemphasizes one aspect of our city. Further, the articles needlessly involve discussions of events that have no relevance in Downey (for example, the Rodney King incident and aftermath, and the OJ Simpson trial; during the Watts' riots, the wonderful Downey Police Department set up checkpoints at key entrances to the city and prevented rioters from entering the city.)

For years Bob commuted to his office in West L.A., and in the early 1970s considered moving to one of the "high end" communities near where he worked. However, after carefully checking some such areas, he and Jean elected to stay in Downey and Bob moved his office to Downey. Our city has been and still is a wonderful city in which to live and raise a family. Here are some of the reasons Vicki and Bob continue to reside here:

Good city government. Downey is a "full service" city, with an efficient, fiscally sound and (to the best of our knowledge) honest government. Its police, fire and community service/recreation departments are excellent.

Schools. The Downey Unified School District is one of the best, and local private schools are good. The school district's board of trustees years ago made a policy decision to set the teacher pay scale on a higher level and the results are shown in the classrooms. There are a number of quality private schools.

Churchs. There are a variety of denominations which minister to their parishioners, many of whom contribute their time to benefit the community.

YMCA. With volunteers, the YMCA has helped thousands of vulnerable children during crucial youth years.

Service Clubs. All of which have a number of capable members who contribute hours of talented service throughout our city.

Businesses. The city has many helpful businesses and professional services easily available to all residents. In recent years, started in the 1990s by the city council, it acquired ownership to the property which earlier was occupied by North American Rockwell, and has developed it with top end stores, restaurants, a park and space center, and a

We could continue with positive comments. Yes, demographic changes have occurred in Downey. Many of our good friends and neighbors speak Spanish. Bob's mother's first language was Spanish. The key for the viable future of Downey is that all capable residents in the future be involved, when able, by volunteering use of their talents towards the betterment of the community and its residents. We plan to do so (Bob is nearly age 90 and Vicki is age 85).



They celebrated sixty-one years together before he passed in October, 2015. They parented seven children: Patti Frisco, Charles E. Frisco Jr., Joanne Frisco Stathoulis, Christopher Frisco, Janine Frisco Poletti, Craig Frisco and Jacquie Frisco Habsburg. They had eight grandchildren, Charles Stathoulis, George Stathoulis, Garryn Laws, Elizabeth Fellmeth, Samantha Poletti, Taylor Knudson Frisco, Thomas Poletti Jr. and Giancalo Christopher Frisco. They had three great grandchildren: Joanne Stathoulis, Sophia Fellmeth and another arriving any moment, Panayotis Stathoulis.

Marjorie was very active in the legal community where she served as president of the Southeast Lawyers Wives. During her term, she introduced Law Day to the Southeast Courts as well as assisted in its name change to become the Southeast Auxiliary Committee. Marjorie also introduced Law Day to the Southeast Bar Courts and became a writer for the Southeast Bar Belles Newsletter. 
